Background/C o n t e x t: (1 Kings 16:29-34)

God calls o r d i n a r y p e o p l e for His service
(1 Kings 17:1; 1 Cor 1:26-29; 1 Sam 16:7)

God will p r o t e c t those who s e r v e Him
(1 Kings 17:2; Psalm 32:7; 91:14)

God p r o v i d e s for our n e e d s as we serve Him
(1 Kings 17:3; Matt 6:31-33; Phil 4:19)

God p r e p a r e s us a s we are serving Him (1 Kings 17:4-7)
