**Recipient:** It was written to <u>T i m o t h y</u> ("honoring God") who was from Lystra, born of a Jewish mother and Gentile father and whom Paul enlisted to accompany him in his ministry (Acts 16:1-3)

Purpose/Theme: To instruct and encourage both Timothy and the church in Ephesus concerning sound doctrine and conduct. (3:14-15)
