What is the importance of the church?

The church has a vital role to play in the world because of:

- our identity (1 Tim 3:14-15a-b)
  - as God's family, we are to reflect Christ through our relationships (Eph 2:19-22; 3:14-15)
  - as God's assembly, we are to reflect Christ through His presence and power (Acts 14:15; 1 Thess 1:9; 2 Cor 4:4-7; Eph 3:17-21)
- our mission (1 Tim 3:15c-16)
  - as God's church we are to be custodians of the truth (1 Tim 3:15c; 1 Pet 2:4-10; 2 Cor 4:1-6; Phil 1:7)
  - as God's church we are to declare that truth and make Jesus Christ known to the world (1 Tim 3:16)

The church is important because it reveals Christ, even as Christ reveals God.
