Part 2 – The Wilderness – Selected Scripture

Upon our salvation (born again, new life) God takes us to the wilderness to change our focus from the past to the future.

That involves beginning to learn about God:

- His identity - He is awesome and powerful
(Exo 19:16-22; 20:18-21; Matt 27:45-54; 2 Cor 13:4; Eph 1:19-23)
- His revelation - an understanding of His Word
(Exo 19:1-8; 20:1-17; Deut 6:1-8; John 17:17; Col 3:16; 2 Tim 3:16-17; 1 Peter 2:2)
- His holiness - an awakening to His worship
(Exo 23:25; 33:9-10; Lev 11:44-45; 22:2,9,16,32; Psalms 29:2; Eze 36:22-23; Rom 12:1-2; 1 Peter 1:13-15; Heb 12:14-15)
- His presence - an awareness of His guidance
(Exo 13:20-22; 40:36-38; Num 9:15-23; Matt 28:20; John 14:26; 16:13-15; 2 Cor 2:14)
- His purposes - growing in obedient faith
(Exo 34:11-14; Deut 27:10; 1 Sam 15:22; John 14:15, 23-24; 1 John 5:3-5)

The wilderness is the place we are tested and our responsiveness to God is revealed
(Deut 8:2; Luke 4:1-13; Heb 3:7-4:2)

The wilderness reveals our:

- satisfaction with our carnality and immaturity
(Num 13-14; Rom 8:5-17; 1 Cor 3:1-3; Heb 5:11-14)
- willingness to advance spiritually to maturity
(Num 14:5-9; Eph 4:11-15; Heb 12:2-3; 6:1-2; Phil 3:7-14)
