The battle against sin is never finished
(Joshua 13:1-7, 13; 16:10; 17:12-13)

Securing my inheritance involves:

- following the Lord faithfully (Josh 14:6-10; Num 14:23-24; 32:11-12; Deut 1:36; Josh 14:8,9,14)
 - believing God's promises
(vs 6-9; Luke 7:1-10; 2 Cor 1:18-20; Heb 11:1-40)
 - waiting for God's time (v 10; 1 Sam 24:8-15; Psalm 37:14; Gal 4:4; 1 Tim 6:12-16)
- having faith in God, not myself
(Joshua 14:10-14; Psalm 20:7; Isa 31:1)
- obeying God's commands
(Joshua 15:13-15; Gen 6:22; 1 Sam 15:22-23; Acts 4:19)

- passing on a godly legacy
(Joshua 15:16-19; Deut 6:1-9; Psalm 128:1-6; 103:17-18)
- not complaining and getting engaged
(Joshua 17:14-18; Matt 25:29; Luke 16:10; Heb 12:1-2)
