## The parable explained (Matthew 13:18-23)

- Sower: Jesus
- Seed: the message of the kingdom (Word of God)
- Soils: the <u>various</u> individual <u>receptivity</u> to the "seed"
  - Compacted soil Hard, impenetrable, no response
  - Rocky soil Shallow, <u>unsustainable</u>, <u>disingenuous</u> response
  - Thorny/weedy soil neglected, distracted,unproductive response
  - Good soil prepared, <u>receptive</u>, <u>fruitful</u> response

## The parable's <u>p o i n t</u>:

The kingdom of God will come through the <u>declaration</u> of a <u>message</u> that will result in <u>varying</u> responses from its <u>hearers</u>.

The parable <u>a p p l i e d</u> :	
What is	s the <u>condition</u> of the soil of my <u>heart</u> ?
-	<u>respond</u> to the Word of God reveals the <u>ondition</u> of my <u>heart</u> .
