The Future, Earthly Form of the Kingdom (Part 1)
Revelation 19:11-21 (page 871)**

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We have seen that the *Kingdom of God* is:

“already” and “not yet” - that is, it has come in the person of Jesus Christ (*First Coming*) and yet the ultimate realization of the kingdom is yet future (*Second Coming*)

A physical, earthly kingdom was spoken of:

- in the Old Testament
(2 Sam 7:16; Ps 2:6-9; 72:1-19; Jer 33:14-21; 23:5-6; Dan 2:27-45; 7:13-14; Isa 9:6-7; 11:6-13; 65:18-25; Amos 9:11-15; Zech 9:9-10; 14:6-21)
- by Jesus (Matt 19:28-30; 25:31-34; Luke 22:29-30)
- in the New Testament (Luke 1:30-33; Acts 3:19-21; Romans 11:25-27; Rev 11:15; 20:1-15)

The arrival of the King (Revelation 19:11-21)

He appears from heaven in victorious power (19:11-15)

He comes as God to rule and reign (19:11-12; 13, 16)

His purpose in coming is:

- the judgment of the wicked (19:15-21)
- the establishment of His kingdom
