## His <u>n a m e s</u>:

- Satan = "a d v e r s a r y or o p p o s e r"
   (Job 1:-2; Zech 3:1; Matt 4:10; Rev 12:9; 20:2)
- The Devil = "s I a n d e r e r"
   (Matt 4:1; Eph 4:27; 1 Pet 5:8; Rev 12:9; 20:2)

### His character:

- The "Serpent" (Gen 3:1; Rev 12:9);
- "great, red, dragon" (Rev 12:3,7,9);
- the "evil one" (John 17:15; 1 John 5:18-19);
- the "accuser of our brothers" (Rev 12:10);
- the "tempter" (Matt 4:3; 1 Thess 3:5);
- "Beelzebul" (Luke 11:15);
- "Belial" (2 Cor 6:15);
- "prince / ruler of this world" (John 12:31);
- the "god of this world" (2 Cor 4:4);
- the "prince of the power of the air" (Eph 2:2)

## His <u>creation</u>:

- The <u>t i m e</u> (John 1:1-3; Col 1:16-17; Ezek 28:13; Gen 2:8)
- He is a <u>s p i r i t</u> being and he is a <u>c r e a t u r e</u>
   (Ezek 28:12,14-15)
- His <u>characteristics</u> before he <u>sinned</u> (Ezek 28:11-19)
- His <u>s i n</u> (Isaiah 14:12-17; Luke 10:18; 1 Tim 3:6;
   Ezek 28:16; Rev 12:4)

## The <u>activities</u> and <u>aim</u> of Satan:

- Relative to <u>G o d</u>: in order to attack God's program and purposes, Satan offers a <u>c o u n t e r f e i t</u> kingdom (Gen 1:27-28; 3:1-5; John 12:31; 1 John 5:19; 2 Cor 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17; Luke 4:5-7)
- Relative to <u>C h r i s t</u>: he <u>o p p o s e s</u> in every way Christ's <u>m i s s i o n</u> to fulfill God's <u>p u r p o s e s</u> (Gen 3:15)
  - by <u>preventing</u> His <u>arrival</u> (Ex 1:15 / Matt 2:16; Gen 4:25; Gen 6:1-8; 1 Sam 18:25; 19:9-10; etc)
  - by <u>tempting</u> Christ <u>personally</u> (Matt 4:1-11; Luke 4:1-13)
- Relative to the <u>Nations</u>: he deceives them to believe that they can govern <u>righteously</u> and bring <u>peace</u> in the world apart from <u>Christ</u> (Rev 13:2-4; 16:13-16)

- Relative to <u>u n b e l i e v e r s</u>: he uses any aspect of the <u>w o r l d</u> system he rules over to keep people from <u>t h i n k i n g</u> about or <u>r e s p o n d i n g</u> to what will bring them into the kingdom of God
  (2 Cor 4:4; 1 Tim 4:1-5; Col 2:8, 23)
- Relative to believers hetempts us to:
  - ° conform to the pressures and philosophy of this world (1 Thess 3:5; Rom 12:1-2;
- ° <u>c o v e r</u> up our <u>s e l f i s h n e s s</u> (Josh 7:1, 19-22; 2 Sam 11; Acts 5:1-11)
- ° engage in <u>i m m o r a l i t y</u> (Gen 39:5-11; 1 Cor 5:1-2; 7:1-5)
- ° He accuses and opposes us continually (Rev 12:10; 1 Pet 5:8)

## His Destinu:

Satan's power (sin and death) has been <u>c o n q u e r e d</u> by the <u>C r o s s</u> and <u>r e s u r r e c t i o n</u> and he and his angels are eternally <u>c o n d e m n e d</u> to <u>h e I I</u>
(John 12:30-32; Col 2:13-15; Heb 14-17; 1 Cor 15:54-57; Matt 25:41; Rev 20:7-10)
