Question: What do we know about the people of Noah's time before the flood? What does the Bible say about technology in the future?

Line of Cain (Gen 4:6-26)

- Promoted human independence and achievement apart from God

Line of Seth (Gen (5:25-26)

- Promoted worship and dependence on God (Gen 5:21-24; 6:8-9)
- *Result:* continuous evil and violence leading to judgment (Gen 6:1-7; Matt 24:37-39; Dan 12:4)

Question: Does the Bible speak of other life in the universe besides angels and humans?

Several reasons I believe the Bible indicates that there is no life outside of earth....

- The Bible indicates that the effect of the curse of Adam's fall was universal (Rom 8:18-22)
- When Christ appeared in the flesh, He came not only to redeem mankind but the whole creation back to Himself (Rom 8:21; Col 1:19-20; Isa 55:12-13; Rev 5:1-14; 21:1-22:21; 1 Cor 15:28)

- Christ died once for all on the earth (Rom 6:10; Heb 10:10; 1 Pet 3:18)
- Since God will destroy the present creation and make a new heaven and earth, it would mean the extinction of any existing life elsewhere (2 Pet 3:10-12; Rev 21:1-5; Rom 6:10; Heb 9:26)
- The Bible makes no provision for the redemption of any other species - fallen angels for example (Heb 2:16; Matt 25:41)

Question: Are there multiple heavens? What is the "highest heaven"? What is heaven really like?

The Bible indicates that there are three heavens:

- The "first" heaven is the sky - the earth's atmosphere (Gen 1:7-8; Jud 5:4; Matt 16:2; Acts 14:17)
- The "second" heaven is outer space - the domain of the sun, moon, stars, etc (Deut 14:9; Ps 8:3-4; 19:1; Matt 24:29)
- The "third" heaven is the dwelling place of God (1 Ki 8:30; Deut 10:14; Job 22:12; Ps 2:4; 2 Cor 12:2)
