# The Characteristics of a Disciple (10:13-16)

A disciple is to have the right obiect of faith. (vs 13-14)

A disciple is to be <u>r e c e p t i v e</u> to and <u>d e p e n d e n t</u> upon Jesus. (vs 15-16)

## The Dangers of <u>D i s t r a c t i o n</u> for a Disciple (10:17-22)

The young man had a *superficial view*:

• of salvation (vs13)

It is not by doing something to <u>e a r n</u> or <u>m e r i t</u> eternal life.

• of <u>Jesus</u> (v 14)

Jesus affirms His <u>d e i t v</u>.

• of the <u>L a w</u> (vs 15-20)

He regarded obedience as external <u>c o n f o r m i t y</u> without internal <u>p u r i t v</u>.

#### Jesus revealed:

• the error of his thinking (v 21a)

He really could <u>n o t k e e p</u> the demands of the Law.

• the <u>c e n t r a l</u> issue of discipleship (v 21b)

It is allegiance to <u>J e s u s</u> not his wealth.

• the <u>d e s i r e s</u> of the young man's heart (v 22)

He cared more about <u>p o s i t i o n</u> and earthly <u>s e c u r i t i e s</u> than trusting in Jesus for life.

### Jesus' Warning to Disciples (10:23-27)

Possessions can be a h a n d i c a p to following Christ. (v 23-24)

Salvation is the work of G o d, not m a n. (v 25-27; cf Eph 2:8-9)

# The <u>B e n e f i t s</u> of Discipleship (10:28-31)

Disciples who follow Jesus *wholeheartedly* can anticipate in the age to come:

- 1) More spiritually of what they <u>s a c r i f i c e d</u> physically.
- 2) Persecution because of their identification with Jesus.
- 3) <u>Eternal</u> life.
