In response to the accusations (John 5:18) of the religious leaders, Jesus claims that He :

- is equal with God (John 5:19-21)
- is the final judge (John 5:22-23)
- will determine people's destiny (John 5:24)
- has authority over life and death (John 5:25-29)
- always does the will of God (John 5:30)

His point: He is the Lord, He is God.

Digging Deeper....

What observations can you make about Jesus' relationship with His Father? How does this support His claim of deity?

In what sense was Jesus dependent on His Father? Does this make Him less than God? Why or why not? _____

Read vs 19-21...Why was the Jews' failure to honor Jesus a serious matter? Explain. _____
