

We must be *willing...*

To prepare ourselves to move forward with God (vs 10-11)

- Faith *does not neglect* preparation – “*get your supplies ready*“ (v 11)
- Faith requires action – “*you will cross the Jordan*” (v 11)
- Faith believes God’s promises – “take possession of the land God has given you” (v 11)

To set aside our own interest for the good of the community (vs 12-15)

- We are to live up to our commitments to one another (v 12-14; Num 32:16-32; Deut 3:12-20)
- We are to be willing to postpone our own comfort for the sake of others (v 15)

To be united to move forward to pursue God’s will (vs 16-18)

- Unity enables God’s people to realize God’s power – “*we will go...we will obey*” (v 16-17)
- Unity produces accountability (v 18)
