Never forget God's f a i t h f u l n e s s (24:1-13;

2 Tim 2:13; Heb 13:8)

- God has d e l i v e r e d us (vs 2-12; Eph 2:1-7; Col 1:12-14)
- God has b l e s s e d us (v 13; Eph 1:3,7-10)

Never forget our r e s p o n s i b i l i t y (24:14-28;

Matt 6:33; Phil 3:13-14; Heb 12:1)

- We need to make a c l e a r choice (vs 14-18; 1 Ki 18:21)
- We are not to make p r e s u m p t u o u s commitments
(vs 19-24; Ex 19:8; Prov 11:2)
- We will be a c c o u n t a b l e for our decisions (vs 25-28;
Prov 5:4-7; Matt 12:36)

Never forget that God k e e p s His promises (24:29-33)

- What God has promised, He will p e r f o r m to
c o m p l e t i o n (2 Cor 1:18-22; Phil 1:6)
