What's the Difference between a Thermometer and a Thermostat?

- 1. Thermometer instument used for <u>d e t e r m i n i n g</u> temperature.
- 2. Thermostat device used to <u>r e q u l a t e</u> temp.

So how do I move from being a Thermometer to a Thermostat?

- 1. Bring Yourself! (Connect with Others)
 - a) Because God didn't create us to be <u>l o n e r a n g e r</u> Christians! (Gen. 2:18)
 - b) Because each one of us has an <u>e f f e c t</u> on others, even when we aren't <u>h e r e !</u> (Heb. 10:24-25)
 - c) Because each one of us has a <u>p u r p o s e</u> for being here and a <u>g i f t</u> to benefit the whole body!
 (1 Cor. 12:12-31)
- 2. Bring Your Bible! (Connect w/ God)
 - a) Because the Bible is much more than just a <u>b o o k !</u> (Heb. 4:12)
 - b) Because the Bible <u>r e v e a l s</u> God's plan for your <u>s u c c e s s</u>! (Joshua 1:7-8)
 - c) Because the Bible <u>c o n n e c t s</u> us with God!
- 3. Bring a Friend! (Serve All)
 - a) Because it's our <u>life's mission!</u> (Matt. 28:18-20)
 - b) Because it's serving God! (Matt. 25:24-40)
 - c) Because of the "Cheers" principle!

Conclusion: "So What?!"

KEY: Don't simply reflect the temperature around you, change it!
