Worship is voluntarv, not coerced (v 1-2)

- Worship: (verb form) to honor or reverence; to regard with great or extravagant respect, honor or devotion; to perform or take part in worship or an act of worship.
- The opportunity to worship should bring me <u>d e l i g h t</u>. (Ps 28:6-7; 100:1-2)

Worship establishes a f r a m e w o r k for my life (v 3-4a)

Worshipping God reminds me of...

- the foundational realities of my life (Ps 95:1-7; Isa 44:24)
- the <u>u n i t v</u> that God *desires* (Ps 133:1;John 17:20-23; Prov 6:16-19)

Worship *cultivates* my need for <u>relationship</u> with God (v 4b)

- Worship is an <u>a c t</u> of <u>o b e d i e n c e</u> (Jn 4:23-24; 14:23-24; Rom 12:1-2)
- As I worship, my relationship with God is n u r t u r e d (Job 42:1-6; Isa 6:1-5)

Worship keeps me <u>c e n t e r e d</u> on the <u>w i I I</u> of God (v 5)

- "thrones for judgment" are the place where a <u>d e c i s i v e</u> word is announced. (Ps 2; 33:8-9; Isa 46:9-11; Rev 19:15)
- Worship keeps my attention centered on G o d and His W o r d (Neh 8:6; Ps 19:7-14; Isa 26:3)

Worship amplifies my need to depend on God (v 6-9)

- Worship paves the way for praver (v 6-7)
 - Prayer for the <u>w e I f a r e</u> of places that are centers for God's <u>w o r k</u> (Rom 1:8-10)
 - Prayer for the <u>p e o p l e</u> who worship and <u>s e r v e</u> the Lord (Eph 6:18-19; 2 Thess 3:1-2)
- Worship directs us to be <u>c o n c e r n e d</u> with God's <u>c o n c e r n s</u> (v 8-9)
 - We share His concern for <u>p e o p l e</u> (1 Tim 2:1-4; 2 Pet 3:8-9)
 - We share God's concern for His k i n g d o m (Luke 9:62; Acts 14:8-22; 19:8)
