We are to anticipate meeting with God in our worship
(Lev 9:1-6)

- The priesthood is the beginning of a new way of life
(v 1-4; Jn 12:24-26; Lk 9:23-24; Matt 10:39)
- Seeing God's glory should motivate our
obedience (vs 4-6; 2 Tim 2:15; 2 Pet 2:9ff)

We are to approach God on the basis of the blood of the
sacrifice (Leviticus 9:7-21; Exo 32; Gen 22:1-19)

- We must be cleansed before we can serve (vs 7-15a)
- We approach God by His prescribed manner as seen in
the progression of the sacrifices (Jn 14:6; Acts 4:8-12)

Our access to God comes through the intercession of
our High Priest (Lev 9:22-23b; Heb 9:11-15)

We find the assurance of our faith in the reality of God's
presence (Lev 9:23c-24; Heb 10:19-23)
