We are to follow God's precepts in our ministry and accept His discipline (10:1-7)

- We are to take God's holiness seriously (vs 1-2; Ex 6:23; 17:5-6; 24:1-11; 30:34-38; Num 20:1-13)
- How we respond to God's discipline is instructive to others (vs 3-7; Lk 9:57-62; 14:26; Acts 5:1-11; Heb 12:5-11)

We are to guard our ability to function as God's priesthood (10:8-11)

- We are to avoid any influence that impairs our ability to function appropriately as God's priesthood (v 8-9; Eph 5:18)
- We are to be able to clearly distinguish between that which is harmful and that which is helpful (v 10; Eph 5:8-21; Gal 6:1-5)
- We are to instruct others concerning God's truth (v 11; 2 Cor 10:2-5; 1 Cor 2:15-16; Matt 28:18-20)

We are to view our privileges and responsibilities to serve the Lord as holy (10:12-20)

- We are to continually partake of Christ in the course of our service (vs 12-15; Phil 4:13,19)
- We are to serve in sincerity, not by ritual (vs 16-20; Psalm 51:15-17)
