The Bible: The Magnificent Eternal Word of God

There are certain inherent qualities we must accept at the outset:

- God is holy. Because He is holy, He is unable to sin.
Therefore He will preserve the reliability and truthfulness of His Word.
- Since His Word is inspired, “God breathed,” (2 Tim 3:16-17), He will oversee and preserve its integrity. (2 Pet 1:20-21)

- Written over a 2000 year period
- 40 Human writers, one Author.
- One uniform message
- Preserved for the ages. Matt. 24:35
- It has survived:
 - Human and supernatural attacks
 - Translation error
- Comparisons w/ human literature

Psalm 19:7-14

V7. The law of the Lord is perfect, revives the soul
Statutes are trustworthy
Make wise the simple
The sceptic, the atheist, the agnostic: challenge
We have the mind of Christ! (1 Cor. 2:16)

V8. The precepts are right giving joy to the heart!

The commands are radiant, give light to the eyes.

V9. Fear of The Lord is pure.

The ordinances all together righteous!

V10. More precious than gold

Sweeter than honey. It’s a treasure hunt!

It takes WORK!

V11. By them is your servant warned. Keeping them is great reward.

V12-14 David’s Prayer: Who? Discern error, forgive hidden faults.

Lord, Keep me from willful sins. Then...

David admits. “When I sin it’s because I allow sin to rule over me!”

Romans 6:11-14... Learn to NO! thy self.

V14. May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer.
