Because the events are spaced, timed and regulated we are able to <u>determine</u> where we are in <u>history</u> right now. (Matt 16:2-3; 1 Chron 12:32)

Things that were literally and historically <u>true</u> of the nation Israel, picture and reveal the manner in which every believer in Jesus Christ <u>proceeds</u> in their <u>spiritual</u> development today. (1 Cor 10:1-13)
