When it comes to worship, God calls everyone to be involved in serving Him (Lev 24:1-9)

- We are to give our best to the Lord (vs 2,5; Matt 26:6-13; John 12:1-8; 2 Sam 24:18-24; 2 Cor 9:6)
- We are to be concerned first with what goes on in the presence of God than what happens elsewhere (vs 3-4, 8-9; Isa 6:1-9; Exo 33:11-12; Luke 10:38-42; Gal 1:15-19)

God's name is to be treated with respect and honor (Lev 24:10-24)

- *Blasphemy* = either by word or by action, the defamation of God's character and glory.
- When we are faced with an important decision, we should not act until we know God's will (vs 12-16; Psalm 27:14; 130:5-6; Josh 6:1-5; 78:1-13; 1 Sam 30:3-8)
- The punishment is to be equal to the crime (vs 17-22; 1 Cor 5:1-5, 11-13; Rev 18:4-8)

- The punishment is to be administered equally to all (vs 13-16; Rom 2:5-11)
- We are to seek to develop habits of godly conduct which become a way of life (Eph 4:25-32; Phil 2:1-5; Col 3:12-17)

Seeing Jesus in Leviticus 24.....

Jesus is both the Light of the world and the Bread of life (John 6:35; 8:12)

Jesus has taken the punishment for our blasphemy and in Him we can be forgiven and redeemed from our sin (Rom 6:23; 1 Tim 1:12-17)
