## To limit the <u>a b u s e</u> of vows:

- God allowed specific <u>f i n a n c i a l</u> equivalents to be made in <u>p l a c e</u> of people who were <u>v o w e d</u> (27:1-8;
   1 Sam 1:1-2:11; Num 6:1-21; Exo 21:32)
- God allowed certain possessions to be redeemed at a higher, penalty price (27:9-25)
  - <u>Livestock</u> (vs 9-13; Mal 1:13-14)
  - <u>Houses</u> (vs 14-15)
  - Fields (vs 16-25)
- God did n o t allow redemption on o t h e r possessions vowed or on things that a l r e a d y b e l o n g e d to Him (27:26-33)
  - The firstborn (vs 26-27; Exo 13:2)
  - "<u>D e v o t e d</u>" things (vs 28-29; Josh 6:17-19, 7:11-15, 20-21; Num 21:2-3; Deut 13:12-18)
  - <u>Tithes</u> (vs 30-33)

Vows in the New Testament are spoken of more in the sense of truthfulness and keeping ourword (Matt 5:33-37; 23:16-22; Eph 4:15, 25)

## Life Observations:

- We are to be <u>c a r e f u l</u> not to make <u>p r o m i s e s</u> or commitments we will not <u>k e e p</u>
   (Jud 11:29-40; Luke 14:25-33; 1 Tim 5:11-15)
- We are not to use our promises or commitments to <u>a v o i d</u> our <u>r e s p o n s i b i l i t i e s</u> to <u>o t h e r s</u>
   (Matt 15:5-9; Mark 7:9-13; Luke 9:57-62)
- We are to <u>k e e p</u> our <u>w o r d</u>
   (Num 30:1-2; Ecc 5:4-5; Matt 5:37; James 5:12)
