Because Jesus is <u>superior</u> to Moses, I am to consider:

- and continually fix my attention on Jesus (Heb 3:1)
 - As the <u>A p o s t I e</u> Jesus presents <u>G o d</u> to <u>u s</u>
 (John 1:14; 14:7-9; Heb 1:2)
 - As the <u>High Priest</u> He presents <u>us</u> to <u>God</u>(Heb 5:1; 9:24)
- how they were both <u>faithful</u> in their <u>responsibilities</u> (Heb 3:2; Num 12:6-8; John 8:29; 17:4-5)
 - "House" = is a reference to people, not to a building
 - Moses was faithful over God's "<u>e a r t h l y</u>" people, <u>l s r a e l</u>
 (1 Cor 4:2)
 - Jesus is faithful over God's "h e a v e n l y" people, the
 c h u r c h (Ephesians 2:19; 1 Peter 2:4-5)

- the <u>significant</u> <u>contrast</u> of Christ's work over that of Moses' work (Heb 3:3-6a)
 - Moses, as <u>s e r v a n t</u>, was <u>p a r t</u> of the <u>h o u s e</u> but
 Jesus as the <u>S o n</u>, is the <u>b u i l d e r</u> of the house
 (v 3; John 8:35; Matt 16:15-18)
 - Moses spoke about <u>t h i n g s</u> to <u>c o m e</u> but Jesus, as the builder, is the <u>f u I f i I I m e n t</u> of <u>t h o s e</u> things (vs 4-6a; Deut 18:15-18; John 5:46)
- my <u>responsibility</u> to hold on to <u>Jesus</u> as He holds on to <u>me</u> (Heb 3:6b; 1 John 2:19; John 6:39; Num 14:26-38)
