Because Jesus is superior to Moses, I am to consider :

- and continually fix my attention on Jesus (Heb 3:1)
 - As the Apostle Jesus presents God to us
(John 1:14; 14:7-9; Heb 1:2)
 - As the High Priest He presents us to God
(Heb 5:1; 9:24)
- how they were both faithful in their responsibilities
(Heb 3:2; Num 12:6-8; John 8:29; 17:4-5)
 - “House” = is a reference to people, not to a building
 - Moses was faithful over God’s “earthly” people, Israel
(1 Cor 4:2)
 - Jesus is faithful over God’s “heavenly” people, the church (Ephesians 2:19; 1 Peter 2:4-5)

- the significant contrast of Christ’s work over that of Moses’ work (Heb 3:3-6a)
 - Moses, as servant, was part of the house but Jesus as the Son, is the builder of the house
(v 3; John 8:35; Matt 16:15-18)
 - Moses spoke about things to come but Jesus, as the builder, is the fulfillment of those things
(vs 4-6a; Deut 18:15-18; John 5:46)
- my responsibility to hold on to Jesus as He holds on to me
(Heb 3:6b; 1 John 2:19; John 6:39; Num 14:26-38)
