Melchizedek's priesthood is superior to Aaron's because (Heb 7:1-3):

- His priesthood is a <u>r o v a l</u> priesthood he is a <u>k i n q</u>! (v 1)
 - Salem = the ancient name for <u>Jerusalem</u> (Ps 76:2)
 - His royalty is mentioned <u>f o u r</u> times in vs 1-2
- He is a <u>priest</u> of the <u>Most High</u> God (v 1)
 - El Elyon = God the <u>h i g h e s t</u> God

Significance: Jesus is the perfect king and perfect priest

- His priesthood is <u>u n i v e r s a l</u>, not <u>n a t i o n a l</u>, in scope (v 1)
- Significance: Jesus is not just the Messiah of <u>I s r a e I</u>, but of the whole <u>w o r I d !</u>
- His priesthood was one of <u>righteousness</u> and <u>peace</u> (v2)
 - Melchizedek = melech "king" Salem (Shalom) "peace"
- Significance: Jesus is true righteousness and true peace (1 John 2;1; Acts 3:14; Rom 5:1; Eph 2:14; Col 2:20)
- His priesthood was <u>n o t h e r e d i t a r y</u>, but <u>p e r s o n a l</u> (v 3)
 - Melchizedek's origin and parentage are <u>i r r e l e v a n t</u> to his priesthood
- Significance: Jesus' priestly qualifications were not due to His earthly <u>lineage</u>, but because of His personal <u>worth</u>, His <u>guality</u>.

- His priesthood was eternal, not temporary (v3)
 - Melchizedek's priesthood had n o t i m e or t e m p o r a l boundaries

Significance: Jesus' priesthood is <u>e t e r n a l</u> (Heb 5:6; 6:20; 7:17, 20)

Melchizedek's priesthood is <u>p r o v e n</u> to be superior because (Hebrews 7:4-10):

- Abraham voluntarily tithed to Melchizedek (v4)
- The one to whom <u>A b r a h a m</u> paid tithes Melchizedek was <u>s u p e r i o r</u> to the one to whom Abraham's <u>d e s c e n d a n t s</u> paid tithes the Levitical <u>p r i e s t s</u> (v 5-6; Num 18:21-26)
- The greatness of Melchizedek was <u>recognized</u> by Abraham whose <u>acceptance</u> of the blessing acknowledged his <u>superiority</u> (vs 7)
- Melchizedek's priesthood is greater because it is permanent (v 8)
- The Levitical priesthood has a c k n o w l e d g e d
 Melchizedek's superiority through A b r a h a m 's prior actions (vs 9-10)

Point:

Melchizedek is a <u>t y p e</u> of Christ and has a <u>s u p e r i o r</u> priesthood to <u>A a r o n</u> and the <u>L e v i t i c a l</u> priesthood.
