**Review:**

The basis and demonstration for Christ's mediatorship in the New Testament is His sacrificial death (Heb 9:11-15)

**Hebrews 9:16-28:**

In order to mediate the New Covenant, Christ's better sacrifice was necessary because (Heb 9:16-28):

- A will (testament ) requires death (Heb 9:16-18)
- Forgiveness requires blood  
(Heb 9:18-26; Exo 20:1-24:18; Gen 15:1-21)
- Judgment demands a substitute (Heb 9:27-28)

**Point:**

Because of His superior sacrifice, Jesus Christ has become the mediator of a superior covenant.
