We are to persevere in faith by:

Remembering that Jesus is the foundation of our confidence (Heb 10:19-21)

- The sacrifice of Jesus has:
  - given us full access to God's presence (vs 19-20; 2 Cor 5:21; Matt 27:51)
  - provided us with a great High Priest (v 21-21; 3:5-6; 4:14)

Realizing that the work of Jesus calls us to obedient action (Heb 10:22-25)

- We are called to:
  - draw near to God in faith (v 22)
  - Hold on to God's promises with hope (v 23)
  - Encourage one another in love (vs 24-25)

Understanding that ignoring the work of Jesus has severe consequences (Heb 10:26-31)

- Living with disregard to Christ's sacrifice leads to God's judgment because:
  - Jesus is rejected (v 29a)
  - His sacrifice is treated as insignificant (v 29b)
  - It is an insult to the Holy Spirit (v 29c)

Determining to persevere in faith to the end (Heb 10:32-39)

- Finish well and be encouraged by:
  - *Considering* your endurance in the past (vs 32-34)
  - *Receiving* God's promises in the present (vs 35-36)
  - *Looking* for Christ's return in the future (vs 37-39)
