Background:

A h a b = king of I s r a e l (*northern kingdom*) u n g o d l y

Jehoshaphat = king of J u d a h (*southern kingdom*) g o d l y

The Circumstances (1 Kings 22:1-6)

Standing A l o n e (1 Kings 22:7-28)

Speaking the t r u t h means that:

- we have developed a g o d l y r e p u t a t i o n (vs 7-8a)
- we will be h a t e d by the u n g o d l y (v 8b)
- we will not c o m p r o m i s e God's W o r d (vs 13-14)
- even though alone, we will remain c o u r a g e o u s and f a i t h f u l to the t r u t h (vs 15-23)
- we are willing to e n d u r e the c o n s e q u e n c e s of our stand for the truth (vs 24-27; Matt 5:11-12)
- we can be b o l d and c o n f i d e n t in what we say (v 28)

The Consequences (1 Kings 22:29-40)

- We will be v i n d i c a t e d by God in His t i m e (vs 34-36; 17)
- Those who r e j e c t God's Word will experience His j u d g m e n t (vs 37-40; 1 Kings 21:19)
