Peter's Confession of Faith (Luke 9:18-21)

"Who do you say I am?" Famous words of Jesus...and, perhaps, a more famous response by Peter.

The Triumphal Entry (Mark 11:1-10)

The people expected and wanted a king...but what they really needed was a Savior!

Blind Bartimaeus (Mark 10:46-52)

1. What do you **BELIEVE** about Jesus? (Mark 10:46-47)
2. How **DETERMINED** are you to get to Jesus? (Mark 10:48)
3. When Jesus calls to you, how will you **RESPOND**? (Mark 10:49-50)

4. How **DESPERATE** are you to be changed by Jesus? (Mark 10:51-52)

Closing:

Bartimaeus **BELIEVED** that Jesus could heal him. He was **DETERMINED** to get to Jesus no matter what the "crowd" thought or said or did. He **RESPONDED** in faith to Jesus call and received healing by means of his faith because of his **DESPERATE** desire to be changed by Jesus.

This morning, Jesus is calling to you and simply asking, "Who do you say I am?" What will your response be?!
