"Who do YOU say I am?" (Matthew 16:13-16)

As you read through the Gospel of John, you will encounter several different conversations in which Jesus makes very specific, far reaching, and outrageous statements about himself.

- Jesus does not just claim to KNOW these things, or EXPLAIN these things. He blatantly claims that He IS these things.
- If TRUE, the implications and impact are tremendous.
- If true, these statements demand a RESPONSE from us today.

1. Jesus says, "I am the LIGHT of the world!"
(John 8:12; John 1:1-5; Isaiah 9:2)

2. Jesus says, "I am the BREAD of life!"
(John 6:35; John 10:10)

3. Jesus says, "I am the WAY, the TRUTH and the LIFE!" (John 14:6; John 6:44)

4. Jesus says, "I am the RESURRECTION and the LIFE!" (John 11:25; 2 Corinthians 5:17)

Closing:

Jesus said that he was the LIGHT of the world;
that he was the BREAD of life.
He claimed to be the WAY, the TRUTH, and the LIFE,
and finally, that he was and is the RESURRECTION
and the LIFE.

What will you do with Jesus this Easter morning? How will you react to His claims? Who do y o u say that Jesus is?!
