God is looking for <u>servants</u> who:

• have a <u>clear</u> spiritual <u>perspective</u> (1 Sam 17:1-30; Eph 6:10-18)

Who are not <u>deterred</u> by what:

- ° others <u>t h i n k</u> (vs 11, 24)
- $^{\circ}$ others <u>s a y</u> (vs 25, 27-30)
- <u>live</u> out their faith <u>practically</u> (1 Sam 17:31-40) It requires that we have a faith that is <u>rooted</u> in:
 - ° personal experience (vs 31-36; Rom 5:3-5)
 - ° the living God and not human methods (vs 37-40)
- are <u>f o c u s e d</u> on His <u>g I o r y</u> (1 Sam 17:41-54)
- learn to follow before they lead (1 Sam 17:55-58)

Life Lessons:

- 1. Actively <u>p u r s u e</u> a personal worldview that is founded on a <u>s p i r i t u a l</u>, and not worldly, <u>p e r s p e c t i v e</u>.
- 2. Live out <u>e v e r y</u> area of your life so that it is directed to <u>d e m o n s t r a t i n g</u> God's <u>g I o r y</u> to all those around you.
