2 Samuel 11 Review: The Downward Spiral of Sin

First, sin is CONCEIVED. (2 Samuel 11:1-3)

Second, sin is BIRTHED. (2 Samuel 11:4)

Finally, sin DESTROYS. (2 Samuel 11:5-chapter 20 and beyond)

What is the best way to be confronted with your sin?!

4 Things about sin we really must know:

1. It's FOOLISH to think you can sin and GET AWAY with it! (1-9; Num 32:23; Prov 15:3; Luke 12:2; Galatians 6:7-9)

2. There are CONSEQUENCES for sin...even FORGIVEN sin! (10-19; Isaiah 59:1-2; Romans 6:23; Hebrews 10:26-27; James 2:10)

3. You must OWN your sin, ask God's FORGIVENESS, and CHANGE! (20-25; Proverbs 28:13; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 4:22-24; 1 John 1:8-9)

4. Through God...there's always REDEMPTION! (26-31; Isaiah 44:22; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Ephesians 1:7-8; Colossians 1:13-14, 20-22; Titus 2:11-14)

What have you been ignoring in your spiritual closet that must be faced and dealt with?

What's it going to take to own it, seek forgiveness and change?

Why is it so critical to remember that through God...there's always redemption?!
