Psalm 96:3; Matt 10:32-33, 21:1-11; Rom 15:13; 1 Peter 3:15)

3. The Pharisees...R E J E C T I N G hope! (Luke 19:37-40;
John 3:16-18, 12:47-48; Rom 2:8; 2 Cor 4:4)
