- Justification The <u>ACT</u> of God whereby He <u>DECLARES</u> the believing sinner <u>RIGHTEOUS</u> in Christ on the basis of the <u>FINISHED</u> <u>WORK</u> of Christ on the <u>CROSS</u>.
 - Justification is an ACT, not a PROCESS.
 - Justification is something <u>GOD</u> <u>DOES</u>, not man.
 - Justification does not mean that God MAKES us righteous, but that he DECLARES us righteous.

Characteristics of righteousness in Romans 3:21-31

- 1. Righteousness is <u>A P A R T</u> from the law. (vs 21; Rom 7:12; Gal 2:21)
- 2. Righteousness is through <u>FAITH</u> in Christ. (vs 22a; James 2:19)
- 3. Righteousness is for ALL men. (vs 22b-23)

- 4. Righteousness is by <u>G R A C E</u> . (vs 24; Eph 2:8)
- 5. Righteousness comes at great COST to God. (vs 25a)
- 6. God's righteousness is in perfect <u>JUSTICE</u>. (vs 25b-26; Hosea 6:6; 1 John 1:5, 4:8)
- 7. God's righteousness <u>ESTABLISHES</u> the law. (vs 27-31)
