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The *perceptions* of people were <u>r e v e a l e d</u> by Jesus - there are those who:

• have <u>n o n e e d</u> for Jesus (Mark 14:1-2)

It happens when we:

- $\sqrt{}$ Consider Jesus a <u>t h r e a t</u> to our plans
- $\sqrt{}$ Use God's Word to <u>c o v e r</u> our sin
- understand that Jesus is evervthing (Mark 14:3, 6-9)

It happens when we:

- $\sqrt{}$ Realize that Jesus is <u>w o r t h v</u> of <u>a I I</u> we have
- $\sqrt{}$ Are concerned with giving <u>h o n o r</u> to Jesus.
- fail to comprehend the <u>significance</u> of Jesus (Mark 14:4-5)

It happens when we:

- $\sqrt{}$ View life from a <u>m a t e r i a l</u> instead of a <u>s p i r i t u a l</u> perspective
- √ View extravagant <u>d e v o t i o n</u> to Jesus as <u>u n n e c e s s a r v</u>
- are more interested in their <u>p e r s o n a l g a i n</u> than in Jesus (14:4, 10-11)

It happens when we:

- $\sqrt{}$ Put o u r plans ahead of G o d's plans
- √ Are more concerned with <u>o u r</u> comfort than <u>t h o s e</u>

 Jesus came to comfort

The Question...."How <u>m u c h</u> is <u>J e s u s w o r t h</u> to me?"

My <u>perception</u> of Jesus will *establish* my <u>priorities</u> about *how I live* my life.
