- Worship = W o r t h - ship
- Worship is NOT about o u r c o m f o r t (Ps. 134:1-3)
- Worship is a v e r b. Fall prostrate, lift hands, shout, face down (Ps. 63:3-4)
- Worship is a f o r e t a s t e of Heaven. (Rev. 5)

Worship is i n t i m a t e (Ps. 63:1-8)

- Balancing h e a d & h e a r t
- Your l o v e l i f e with God
