It is essential that I become <u>d i s c e r n i n g</u> about the <u>c h a r a c t e r</u> of my friends and associations if I am to *live* wisely (Prov 3:21; 16:21; 18:15)

Wisdom instructs me about <u>r e c o g n i z i n g</u> and <u>i n t e r a c t i n g</u> with those who are:

- <u>Lazy</u> (Prov 10:4; 26:13-14; 21:25)
 - ➤ He won't <u>s t a r t</u> things (Prov 6:9-10; 20:4)
 - ➤ He won't <u>f i n i s h</u> things (Prov 12:27; 19:24; 26:15)
 - ➤ He *always* has an <u>e x c u s e</u> (Prov 22:13; 26:16; 20:4)
 - ➤ He never <u>le arns</u> from experience (Prov 6:6-11; 24:30-34)
- <u>Simple</u> (Prov 8:5)
 - ➤ He is <u>n a ï v e</u> (Prov 14:15,18;)
 - ➤ He lacks <u>i u d a m e n t</u> (Prov 7:7; 9:4-6)
 - ➤ He has to learn the <u>h a r d</u> way (Prov 1:32;19:25;22:3; 27:12)
- Foolish (Prov 1:7; 26:3-12)
 - ➤ He refuses <u>i n s t r u c t i o n</u> (Prov 17:10; 26:3-5; 27:22)
 - He can't c o n t r o l his tongue (Prov 15:2;17:28;18:2; 19:1; 20:3)
 - ➤ He creates <u>p r o b l e m s</u> and brings <u>s o r r o w</u> (Prov 26:9-10; 10:1; 13:20; 17:21)
 - ➤ He doesn't learn from his experience (Prov 26:11; 19:3)
- Mockers (Prov 14:6)
 - ➤ He is <u>a r r o g a n t</u> (Prov 21:24)
 - > He dislikes <u>c o r r e c t i o n</u> (Prov 9:7-8; 13:1; 15:12)
 - ➤ He causes <u>t r o u b l e</u> (Prov 21:24; 22:10; 29:8)
