***Don't Forget to Remember God's F a i t h f u l n e s s***

**(4:1-8)**

- The pile of rocks *in Canaan* bore witness to God's c o m m i t m e n t to His w o r d and to His p e o p l e.

***Don't Forget to Remember God's P o w e r (4:9-18)***

- The pile of rocks *in the midst of the Jordan River* bore witness to God's s t r e n g t h to h o l d back the flood and provide p a s s a g e into the land.

***Don't Forget to Remember to R e m i n d Others About God's M i g h t (4:19-24)***

- To t e a c h future generations (vs 20-23)
- To w i t n e s s to all people (v 24a)
- To e n c o u r a g e one another to w o r s h i p the Lord (v 24b)

**Digging Deeper....**

- The stones *in the Jordan* speak of the d e a t h of Christ (Rom 6:1-4)
- The stones *in Gilgal* speak of the r e s u r r e c t i o n of Christ (Rom 6:5-10)
- When Israel crossed the river, they became citizens of a n e w c o u n t r y, with a n e w l i f e (Eph 2:19; Phil 3:20)
- It was now time to put away their own human efforts and learn to live by f a i t h (2 Cor 5:7; Gal 2:20)
