The Question: Why don't You do something, God? (1:1-4)

God's Response: I am doing something! (1:5-11)

- God doesn't always give us the answers we want or expect.
- God reminds us that human history:
 - √ is under His control (1:5-6)
 - √ is subject to His timetable (1:5)
 - √ Is moving toward His divine kingdom

The Response: Stop and think (1:12)

- Remember what you know to be true about God
 - √ God is unchanging
 - √ God is holy
 - √ God is sovereign
 - √ God is faithful
- Consider how that truth applies to my problem

The Tension: But I am still confused (1:13-17)

- You don't seem to be acting in accordance with what I know about You, God!

The Solution: Commit the Problem to God in faith (2:1)

- Wait on God for understanding
- Expect God to answer
