God’s answer to our questions a s s u r e us of
three c e r t a i n t i e s:

**1. The *certainty* that His g r a c e is s u f f i c i e n t
(Hab 2:2-5; 2 Cor 12:9)**

- My faith will be v i n d i c a t e d
(v 4; Rom 1:17; Gal 3:11; Heb 10:38; 11:6)

**2. The *certainty* that His g l o r y will be r e v e a l e d
(Hab 2:6-14; Isa 42:8-9; Rev 17-18)**

- In the present, God’s j u s t i c e is *perverted* by
 - The g r e e d of people (v 6-8)
 - The u n j u s t means of people (v 9-11)
 - The v i o l e n t acts of people (v 12-13)
- God’s j u s t i c e will t r i u m p h (v 14; Isa 42:1-4)

**3. The *certainty* that His r u l e will p r e v a i l
(Hab 2:15-20; Rev 19-22)**

- In the present God’s r u l e is *challenged* by:
 - The selfish m a n i p u l a t i o n of others (v 15-16)
 - The i d o l a t r y of self-i m p o r t a n c e (v 18-19)
- God’s r i g h t e o u s n e s s will be e s t a b l i s h e d
(v 20; Isa 11:1-10)

Putting it to use:

Grasping the *significance* of these three certainties will allow me
to stop w o r r y i n g and move forward by f a i t h.

God is *always* working for my highest g o o d, even though at
times, that may be a p a i n f u l process.

Regardless of what happens around us or to us – whatever
comes, we are to l i v e by f a i t h.
