How did those at the Cross see Jesus?

- The Roman soldiers saw Jesus as irrelevant to their lives (vs 31-37; Ps 22:18)
- The <u>crowds</u> saw Jesus as a <u>misguided</u> man (vs 39-40; John 6:41-59; 7:1-44; ; 7:1-44; Ps 22:7; 109:25)
- The <u>religious</u> <u>le a ders</u> saw Jesus as a defeated <u>deceiver</u> (vs 41-43; 16:1-4;21:23-27; John 7:45-52)
- God the <u>F a t h e r</u> saw Jesus as the <u>s i n -b e a r e r</u>
 (vs 41-47, 51-53; 2 Cor 5:21; Ps 22:1; Isa 53:6,10)
- The Roman <u>c e n t u r i o n</u> saw Jesus as the
 <u>s i n l e s s</u> One (v 54; 1 Peter 1:18-19; 2:22)
- The <u>d i s c i p l e s</u> saw Jesus as the One they <u>l o v e d</u> (vs 55-56; 1 John 4:19)

How I see Jesus will <u>d e t e r m i n e</u> whether I will learn two simple lessons about the <u>C r o s s</u>:

- The *Cross* reminds me that <u>s i n</u> is <u>c o s t l y</u>
- The *Cross* reminds me that <u>p e o p l e m a t t e r</u> to God.
