When I come to the door of the e m p t y tomb, will I:

- stay o u t s i d e and make my o w n a s s u m p t i o n s? (20:1-2)
  - Failure to i n v e s t i g a t e will cause me to m i s u n d e r s t a n d God's *truth*
- go i n s i d e and a n a l y z e? (20:3-4, 6-7; Luke 24:12)
  - O v e r a n a l y s i s can lead to c o n f u s i o n about God's *power*
- go i n s i d e and b e l i e v e? (20:3-5, 8)
  - F a i t h *does not* mean I understand e v e r y t h i n g God *does*

The *empty tomb* p o i n t s me back to God's t r u t h (20:9)

- The *resurrection* was not a c h a n c e happening
- F a i t h is a p r o c e s s

To think about....

Have you come to the empty tomb of Jesus Christ?

Have you *considered* the *evidence* of the empty tomb?

Will you *go in* and *see beyond* the door?

If you are *willing* to do that, it could **change your life** forever.
