**2 Corinthians 5:15-18** – “<sup>15</sup>And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again. <sup>16</sup>So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. <sup>17</sup>Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! <sup>18</sup>All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:”

### **IDENTITY: What it’s not!**

1. Identity is not about P O S I T I O N, S T U F F or S T A T U S.

### **IDENTITY: What it is!**

1. God sees identity in a very D I F F E R E N T way.  
(1 Samuel 16:7)
2. In God’s eyes, your identity is who you I D E N T I F Y with.  
(Romans 6:3-5; Galatians 2:20)

### **We Need An IDENTITY Change!**

1. Identity is more about A T T I T U D E than A C C O M P L I S H M E N T!  
(Ephesians 4:22-24; Philippians 2:3-8; James 4:13-15)
2. Identity is more about P R I O R I T Y than P O S I T I O N! (Matthew 6:31-34)
3. Identity is more about S E R V I C E than S T A T U S!  
(Matthew 20:25-28; James 2:1-4)
