## I am to <u>respond</u> to the elders by <u>honoring</u> them (1 Thess 5:12-13)

A proper a t t i t u d e toward elders includes:

- Respect (5:12)
- Esteem / highly regard them in love (5:13a)
- Live in <u>p e a c e</u> with each other (5:13c)

Why am I to respond this way?

• Because of the <u>responsibility</u> of their work (5:13c)

## I am to <u>c o n s i d e r</u> how the elders <u>l i v e</u> and <u>m o d e l</u> Christ to me (Hebrews 13:7)

A healthy <u>r e s p o n s e</u> includes:

- Reflecting on their <u>lifestyle</u>
- <u>I m i t a t i n q</u> their <u>f a i t h</u>

# I am to realize that I am spiritually accountable to the elders as they are accountable to God (Heb 13:17)

I am to:

- O b e y and s u b m i t to the a u t h o r i t y of the elders (v 17a)
- Not <u>c o m p l i c a t e</u> their tasks by my <u>d i s o b e d i e n c e</u> (v 17b)

### If an elder <u>s i n s</u>, he is to be <u>d i s c i p l i n e d</u> the way <u>a n y o n e</u> one else in the church would be (1 Tim 5:19-21)

That means:

- An accusation must be <u>c o n f i r m e d</u> by two or three
  <u>e y e w i t n e s s e s</u> (v 19; Deut 17:6; Matt 18:16; 2 Cor 13:1)
- They are to be <u>r e b u k e d p u b l i c l v</u> (v 20a; Matt 18:17)
- The church is to gain a proper <u>f e a r</u> of <u>G o d</u> (v 20b)

#### Living it out....

Respond to the leaders in your church with <u>respect</u> and be <u>accountable</u> to them so that they may serve with <u>ioy</u> and not be <u>burdened</u> by their task.
