The Story That Never Grows Old God's Heart Revealed – Part 2 Selected Scripture

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From the very beginning, God's *heart* was to <u>r e d e e m</u> people and <u>p o i n t</u> them to His <u>S a v i o r</u> to come.

He did this through a sacrifice for:

- an <u>i n d i v i d u a l</u> (Gen 3:21)
- a <u>f a m i l y</u> (Exodus 12:1-30)
- a <u>n a t i o n</u> (Leviticus 16)

The eventual <u>r e s u l t</u> of God's <u>l o v e</u> for *lost people*: the <u>m i s s i o n</u> of His <u>S o n</u>

- God became <u>f I e s h</u>...He became a <u>m a n</u> <u>J e s u s</u> (John 1:14)
- Jesus would be the <u>sacrifice</u> for the <u>whole</u> <u>world</u> (John 1:29-30)
- Because God's love for <u>lost</u> people is <u>limitless</u> (John 3:16)

God's Love for Lost people is seen in the mission of His Son:

- God <u>s e n t</u> His Son <u>t o</u> people to reveal the <u>c h a r a c t e r</u> of His love the <u>m i n i s t r y</u> of Jesus on the <u>e a r t h</u> (Luke 19:10; 23:33-34; John 1:15-18; 5:36-40; 14:8-11; 17:6-10)
- God <u>g a v e</u> His Son <u>f o r</u> people to prove the <u>d e p t h</u> of His love the <u>s a c r i f i c e</u> of Jesus on the <u>C r o s s</u>.
 (John 10:14-18; 12:23-33; 15:13-15; 1 John 4:9-12)
- God <u>r a i s e d</u> His Son <u>f o r</u> people to show the <u>p o w e r</u> of His love the <u>r e s u r r e c t i o n</u> of Jesus from the <u>g r a v e</u>
 (Jn 2:18-22; 11:25; 1 Cor 6:14; 15:42-44; 2 Cor 13:4; Eph 1:19-21)

The coming of God's Son, Jesus Christ, shows us that God's h e a r t is for l o s t people:

- to <u>i n c a r n a t i o n a l l y</u> reveal His <u>c h a r a c t e r</u> through the <u>s e r v i c e</u> of His Son
- to <u>s a c r i f i c i a l l y</u> reveal His <u>l o v e</u> through the <u>d e a t h</u> of His Son
- to <u>p o w e r f u l l y</u> reveal His <u>l i f e</u> through the <u>r e s u r r e c t i o n</u> of His Son

The "Heart" of the issue...Do I share God's heart for lost people by:

- ° Showing them His character by serving them "incarnationally"?
- ° Showing them *His love* by *sacrificing* my desires for *their good*?
- ° Showing them His life by living in His power rather than my own?
