I must learn to <u>s u b m i t</u> to God's ways even when I don't <u>u n d e r s t a n d</u> them (vs 1-7)

- I can always <u>b e I i e v e</u> God's promises (v 2)
- God's strategies are often designed to test our <u>f a i t h</u>
 and <u>o b e d i e n c e</u> (vs 3-7)

Seven = "shevah" - to be <u>f u l l</u>, be satisfied...it represents <u>c o m p l e t e n e s s</u> or perfection

Success comes as I learn to <u>t r u s t</u> and <u>o b e y</u> God (vs 8-21)

- When I obey God's plan, I am assured of God's presence (vs 8-14)
- God is never in a hurry (vs 12-14)
- It is God who gives <u>victory</u> and <u>deliverance</u> (vs 16-17)
- I am not to <u>c o m p r o m i s e</u> with <u>s i n</u> in my life (vs 18-21)

Devoted = "herem" – devoted things or set <u>a p a r t</u> for something

Firstfruits = promise of more to come
