Seeing Jesus Through The Old Testament

Jesus: The Real Thirst Quencher!

Exo 17 ; John 7; 1 Cor 10:1-5; Num 20:1-13

Sunday, July 11, 2010

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Jesus is the Rock that was stricken in the wilderness (Exodus 17:1-7; 1 Corinthians 10:1-5)

- Notice that the rock was to be struck (Ex 17:6)

- Notice the order of these wilderness examples (Ex 16 and 17)

- *Exodus 16* speaks of the incarnation of Christ (*manna* from heaven)

- *Exodus 17* speaks of the crucifixion of Christ (*stricken* of God)

- Notice the occasion of this event (Ex 17:1-3)

- It was the peoples' sin that led to the striking of the rock! (1 Cor 15:3; 1 John 2:2)

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- Notice the i n s t r u m e n t used to strike the rock (Ex 17:5-6)

- It was a s y m b o l of j u d g m e n t (Ex 4:3, 7:17, 8:5, etc; Isa 53:4-5; Acts 2:23; Phil 2:8; Heb 12:2)

- Notice the r e s u l t of the action (Ex 17:6b)

- It is a picture of the g i f t of the H o l y S p i r i t (John 7:37-38; 1 Cor 10:4; 12:12-13)

- Notice the r e s p o n s e of G o d (Ex 17:6)

- The water was a result of G o d ' s g r a c e (Eph 2:5-7; 2 Tim 1:8-10; Tit 2:11)

**Don't m e s s a r o u n d with God's p r o g r a m!
(Numbers 20:1-13)**

- Notice the c i r c u m s t a n c e s of the event (Num 20:1-6)

- Notice the i n s t r u c t i o n s to Moses (Num 20:7-8)

- Notice A a r o n ' s presence (Num 20:2, 6, 8, 10, 12)

- Notice w h o was to w i t n e s s the event (Num 20:8,10)

- Notice Moses' m i s t a k e (Num 20:10-12)

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
