Was used in the <u>wilderness</u> picturing Christ's <u>humiliation</u>	Was used in <u>Jerusalem</u> picturing Christ's <u>glorification</u>
Was outwardly <u>unattractive</u>	Was outwardly <u>magnificent</u>

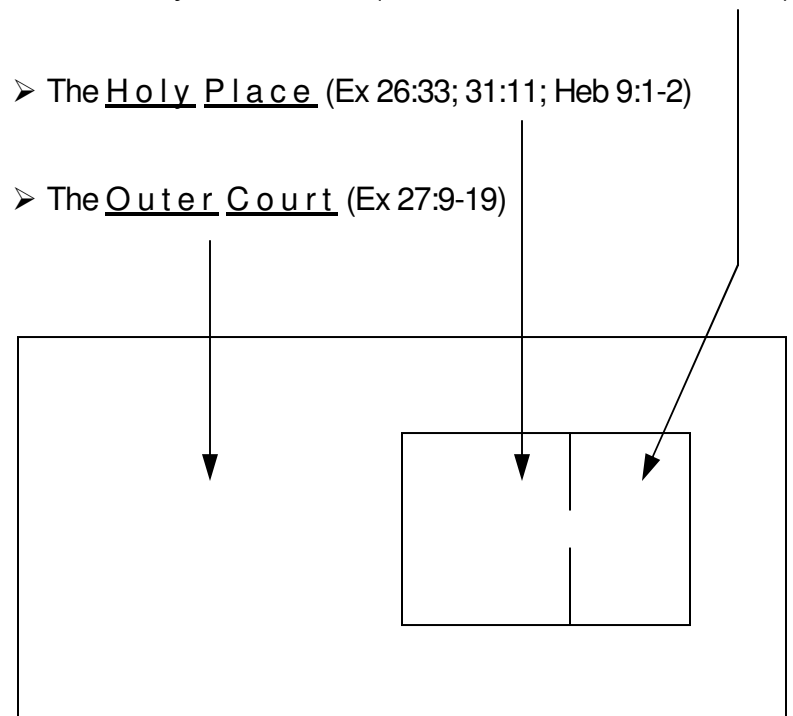

The Tabernacle ...

- Was a forerunner to the Temple in Jerusalem
- Was initiated by God, not man (Ex 25:1-8)
- Was to be made according to a specific pattern (Ex 25:9,40; Heb 8:5; 9:23; 10:1)
- Was comprised of three compartments
 - The Holy of Holies (Ex 26:34; Lev 16:2,16; Heb 9:3)
 - The Holy Place (Ex 26:33; 31:11; Heb 9:1-2)
 - The Outer Court (Ex 27:9-19)



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- Was intended to
 - Be God's d w e l l i n g place in the m i d s t of His people
 - √ *Mishkan* = to d w e l l, d w e l l i n g place, tabernacle
 - Be instructional about the h o l i n e s s of God and the s i n f u l n e s s of mankind
 - Reveal the w a y of s a l v a t i o n
- Is a beautiful t y p e of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 1:14)

Consider these striking comparisons as we begin our study...

The Tabernacle was:

- t e m p o r a r y
- for use in the w i l d e r n e s s (Num 1:1; Luke 2:7; 9:58)
- was outwardly u n a t t r a c t i v e (Ex 26:1-14; Isa 53:2-3)
- God's d w e l l i n g place (Ex 25:8; 40:34-35; John 1:14-15)
- The place where God m e t mankind (Ex 25:21-22; John 14:6; 1 Tim 2:5)

- At the c e n t e r of Israel's camp (Num 2:1-34; Matt 18:20; 2 Cor 1:19-20)
- The place where the L a w was p r e s e r v e d (Ex 25:21; Deut 10:2-5; Matt 5:17)
- The place where s a c r i f i c e was made (Ex 40:29; 29:15-18; Heb 10:12)
- Approached t h r o u g h the tribe of J u d a h (Ex 27:12-17; Num 2:1-3)

The c o n t r a s t s between the T a b e r n a c l e and the T e m p l e:

<i>The Tabernacle</i>	<i>The Temple</i>
Foreshadowed Christ's <u>f i r s t</u> coming	Looked forward to Christ's <u>s e c o n d</u> coming
Was a <u>t e m p o r a r y</u> structure	Was a <u>p e r m a n e n t</u> structure
Was built by <u>M o s e s</u> the <u>P r o p h e t</u>	Was built by <u>S o l o m o n</u> the <u>K i n g</u>

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
