Easter can be heard in:

- a Song (Psalm 118:22-23)

- a Story (Matthew 21:42)

- a Sermon (Acts 4:8-12)
 - √ The *stone* = Jesus Christ (v 10)
 - √ The *builders* = rulers and elders of Israel (v 8)
 - √ The *rejection* of the stone = the crucifixion of Jesus (v 10)
 - √ The *elevation* of the stone to the chief corner stone = the resurrection of Jesus (v 10)
 - √ The *result* of this new position of Jesus = that there is salvation in no other (v 12)

Easter is experienced by considering four aspects of my life:

- *What* am I looking for? (Psalm 118:22-23)
- *What* am I doing? (Matthew 21:42)
- *What* have I done? (Acts 4:8-12)
- *What* will I do? (1 Peter 2:4-8)
