Genesis 18:1-33 (page 11)

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I can be g r a t e f u l that:

God is *gracious* even in my u n b e l i e f (Genesis 18:1-15)

- *Key question:* Could God ever be l i m i t e d in His p o w e r?
- God extends g r a c e even when I d o u b t Him.

God is *gracious* even in j u d g m e n t (Genesis 18:16-33)

- *Key question:* Could God ever be u n j u s t in His j u d g m e n t?
- God always extends g r a c e before bringing j u d g m e n t.

Thinking it through...

When I doubt God, I am questioning both His veracity (truthfulness) and His ability. How would I answer the question, "*Is anything too hard for the Lord?*" Does my answer have anything to do with what I believe about God and who He is?
