The lesson of Judges:

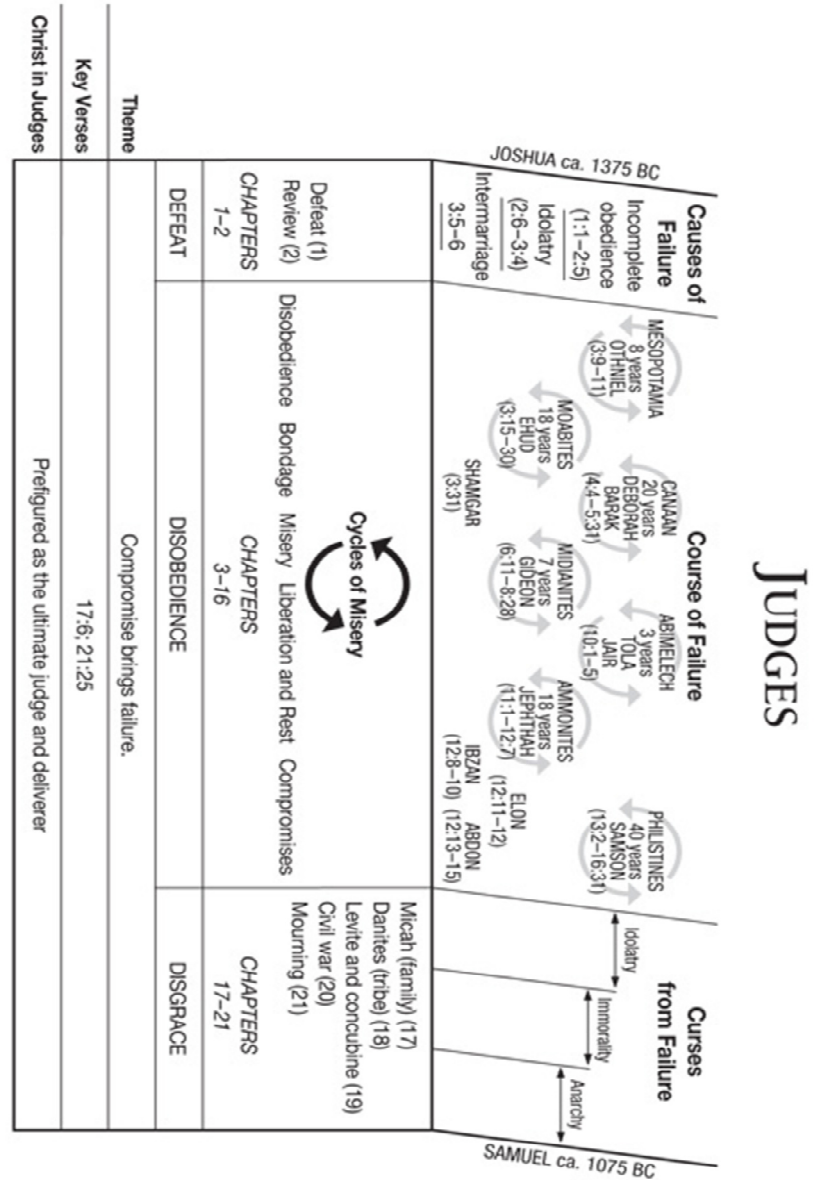
- When God's truth is r e j e c t e d, faith is c o m p r o m i s e d and I begin to live according to my own d e s i r e s.
